Wellness Basics and Vaccination Schedule

Age of Puppy

Vaccination

6-8 Weeks

First examination and first DA2PP vaccination. This helps protect against Canine Distemper virus, Adenovirus (causes canine hepatitis), Parvovirus and Parainfluenza. Depending on the size of your pet, we also may give a Bordetella vaccine intra-nasally (if not given at this appointment, the vaccine will be given at a separate visit). In addition, a routine fecal test and routine deworming will be done.

11-12 Weeks

Second examination and second DA2PP vaccination. Depending on the size and breed of your pet, we also may start the Leptospirosis vaccination. A second routine fecal test and deworming will be done.

14-16 Weeks

Third examination and final DA2PP vaccination (with or without booster for Leptospirosis). First annual Rabies vaccination will be given, as well as a final deworming. Depending on the size of your pet, we also may give a Bordetella vaccine intra-nasally.

6 Months

Spay or Neuter

1 Year and Older

DA2PP with or without Leptospirosis Vaccination – ANNUALLY

Rabies Vaccination—ANNUALLY (dogs that have previously received the one-year Rabies vaccine are eligible for the three-year Rabies vaccine the following year.)

Bordetella Vaccination (Kennel Cough) – EVERY SIX MONTHS

Fecal Exam for Internal Parasites – ANNUALLY

Optional ANNUAL vaccines – Lyme Disease and Canine Influenza
